

# Olympia Multi-Specialty Clinic Ambulatory Procedure Center PLLC Drivers Responsibilities

We appreciate your commitment to your friend or family member. We recognize that agreeing to assist our patient takes time away from busy schedule. When our patients are scheduled they are given a lot of information, and we want to be sure that you are aware of the issues that pertain to their driver.

All drivers MUST come up to our procedure center, located on the third floor of the Physician's Pavilion, Suite #300, with the patient, to be checked in by the receptionist. It is important that we meet you and have a chance to review things with you.

All drivers must then stay within the building, until the patient's procedure is complete, and is ready for discharge. If you wish to leave the waiting area, we need you to let the receptionist know where you are going so we can have a means of contacting you. We can issue you a beeper or call you on your cell phone when the patient is ready for their discharge conference or in the case of an emergency.

We have tried to make the waiting time as pleasant as possible, and have televisions that you can watch as well as access to a wireless internet connection should you want to bring a notebook computer with you.

Areas that you may want to visit while you are waiting include:

Cafeteria	Located on the first floor of the Capital Medical Center.
Main Lobby:	Located on the first floor of the Capital Medical Center, near the cafeteria.
Espresso Stand:	Located outside the Emergency Room waiting area of the Capital Medical Center.
Additional Waiting Area:	Located on the third floor of the Physician's Pavilion, near the elevators

If you have extra people or children with you:

We ask that you use one of the other waiting areas located near the elevators on the third floor of the Physician's Pavilion or the main lobby of the Capital Medical Center. This would be greatly appreciated, as it will help lessen the congestion of our waiting area at the procedure center.

Discharge Conferences:

Each patient undergoes a conference with the physician or assigned nurse, prior to them leaving the procedure center. Please remember, that the patients are still under the effects of the medications used for sedation and will not be able to remember a lot of what is being explained to them. Therefore, if the patient allows, we would like the drivers to be a part of this conference.

We appreciate your cooperation and help in this matter, as our goal is to insure safe care for our patients to include having someone available to drive them home and assist them after their procedure.
